Here's how to join an existing Message Board.

1. Go to <http://www.cruise critic.com/> and Left-click on 'Boards' in the upper-left of the page (**Figure 1**).

2. Left-click on 'Royal Caribbean International' to join blogs about that line's cruises (**Figure 2**).

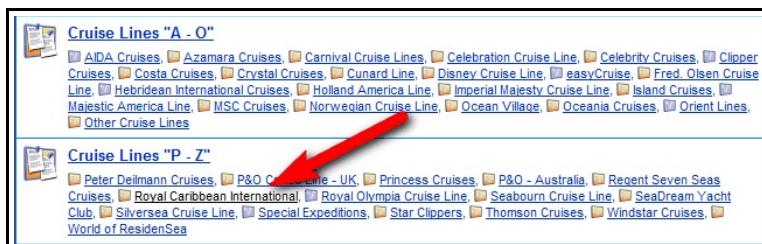

4. Left-click on the cruise you will be joining (**Figure 4**).

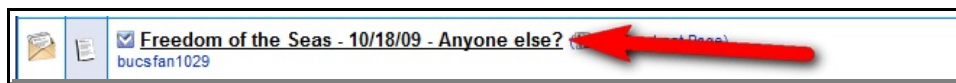

ADD TO FAVORITES

Before you do anything else, add the website to your Favorites.

6. In both Internet Explorer 6 or 7, you can add the site by left-clicking on 'Favorites' ► 'Add to Favorites' (Figure 6).

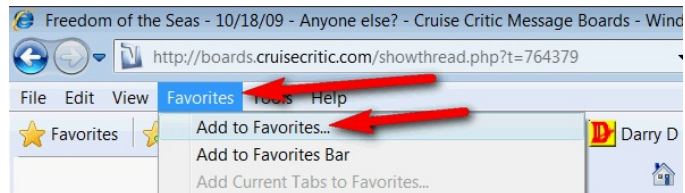

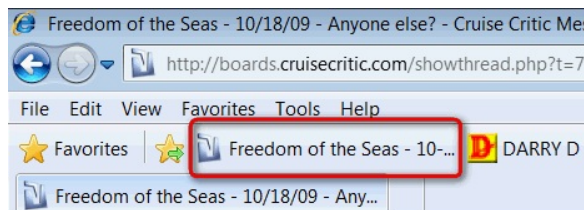
