

PHOTO LINK PASTED INTO CRUISECRITIC COMMENT

Click on the blue, underlined text to go to its linked reference.

When you have your own website, it's simple to paste a photo's link into a comment on CruiseCritic. Here's how to do it.

1. Left-click on the image and its website will appear on the Address Bar (Figure 1, Internet Explorer; Figure 2, Google Chrome).

- ① RIGHT-click on address.
- ② Left-click on "Copy" choice.

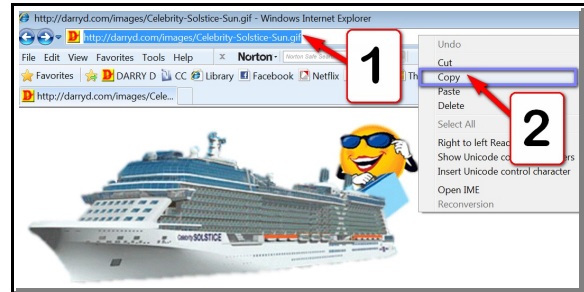

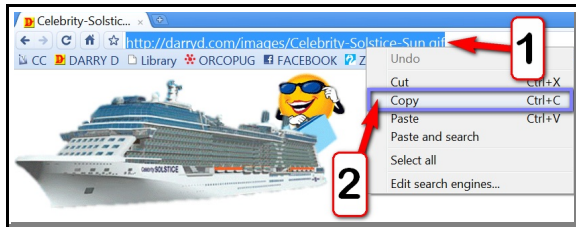

2. If it's a new entry, left-click on "Post Reply" (Figure 3).

If it's a reply to a post, left-click on "Quote" within the post itself (Figure 4).

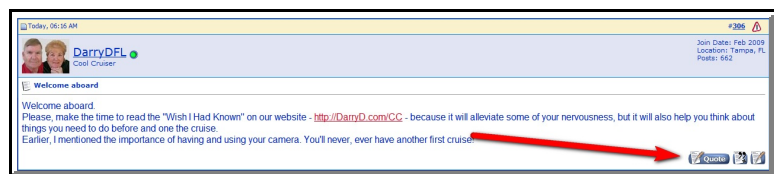

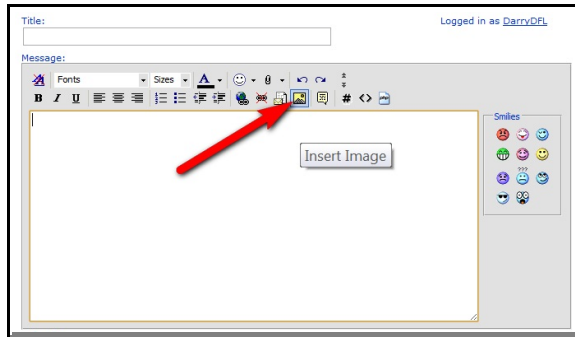

3. Left-click on the “Insert Image” icon in the ToolBar (Figure 5).

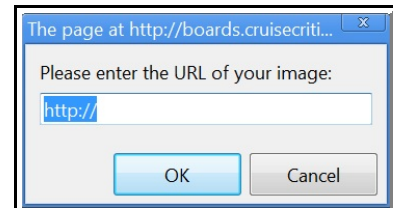

4. A popup window appears (Figure 6).

5. Use the **Ctrl+V** keys to paste in the website address (Figure 7). Click on “OK” or touch the Enter key on your keyboard.

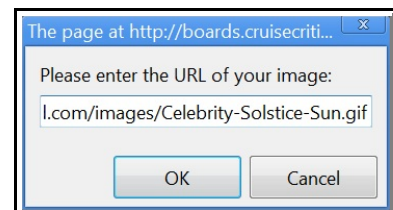

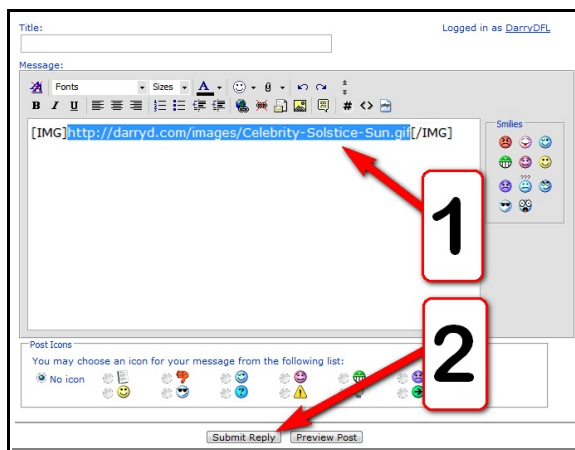

6. The link is entered into the comment.
 ① The URL (web address) of the image appears between the entries [IMG] and [/IMG] which mark the beginning and ending of a website link.
 ② Left-click on “Submit Reply” button.

7. The image appears along with the words you typed (Figure 9).

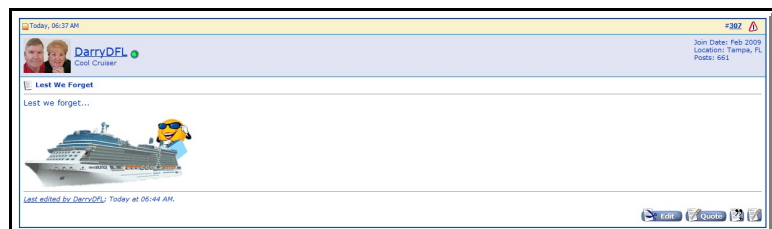
