## SEND PHOTO FROM PHOTO GALLERY

**QUESTION:** When you create a graphic for the Photo Gallery webpage, “Chuck Says,” < <http://darryd.com/Photos> >, you create a “normal name” like “Really Hungry 0609 CM.jpg”. However, when I send that photo from your Gallery to my daughter, the name she sees in the email appears as “Really%20Hungry%200609%20CM.jpg”. How can that be?

### ANSWER:

If a photo, with spaces in its name, is posted to a Website and sent to someone from there, Internet Explorer adds “%20” in the place of that space. That’s because Web browsers do not recognize spaces between characters in file name.

Thus, the original name for that file was “Really Hungry 0609 CM.jpg” which when the spaces are replaced becomes “Really%20Hungry%200609%20CM.jpg”.

By the by, the way to email any photo in that gallery — or any other:

- ❶ RIGHT-click on the photo.
- ❷ Click on “Email Picture...”
- ❸ Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the “OK” button.
- ❹ Type the recipient’s name (if he/she is in your Address Book) or type the email address.
- ❺ Change the Subject if you want.
- ❻ Add any text message you want to send.
- ❼ Click on the “Send” button — or — select File > Send Message from the MenuBar — or use Alt+S keys, on the keyboard.
