QUESTION: Gmail requires cookies to be enabled. I got this warning from Gmail: “Cookies seem to be disabled in your browser. Gmail requires cookies to be enabled in order to operate. To use Gmail, enable cookies by changing your browser’s Preferences or Options. If you have a third-party cookie manager, you will have to configure it to allow cookies from Gmail.” How do I enable cookies in Internet Explorer 7?

ANSWER:

1. Open IE7
2. Select Tools > Options from the MenuBar.
3. Click on the “Privacy” tab.
4. Click on the “Advanced” button (**Figure 1**).
5. In “Advanced Privacy Settings” (**Figure 2**):
 - 1 Ensure there is a check next to “Override...”
 - 2 Click on “Accept” under “First-party...”
 - 3 Click on “Accept” under “Third-party....”
 - 4 Click on
 - 5 Click on “OK” button.

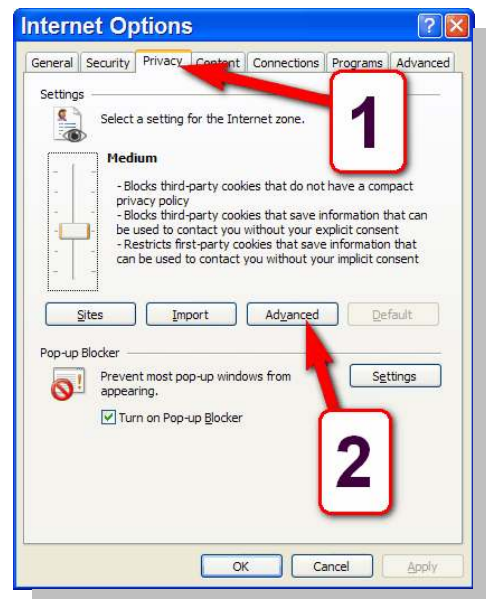
