

# INTERNET EXPLORER 7 UNINSTALL

In the event that you try Internet Explorer 7 and decide that you're rather go back to Internet Explorer 6, you can do it. Here's how.

## UNINSTALL

1. Go to the Control Panel.
2. Click Add or Remove Programs.
3. Click "Show Updates" checkbox.
4. Click whatever version of Internet Explorer 7 you have.
5. Click the "Change/Remove" button.

## UNINSTALL RC1

To uninstall Internet Explorer 7 and restore Internet Explorer 6 when using Windows XP or Windows Server 2003:

- ❶ Click Start, and then click Control Panel.
  - ❷ Click Add or Remove Programs.
  - ❸ Click on Windows Internet Explorer 7
  - ❹ Click Change/Remove.
- If you can *not* find Internet Explorer 7 in Add or Remove Programs:
- ❶ Click Start > Run
  - ❷ Type C:\Windows\ie7\spuninst\spuninst.exe
  - ❸ Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard.
- ★ To do this, you need to have "view hidden folders" enabled.

## ERROR MESSAGE

If you see an error message saying that you can *not* uninstall IE 7 from this user account, you can bypass the check by following these steps.

WARNING: Backup your Registry before you do this.

- ❶ Click Start > Run
- ❷ Type *regedit*
- ❸ Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard.
- ❹ Navigate to HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Internet Explorer.
- ❺ RIGHT-click the Internet Explorer key
- ❻ Click New
- ❼ Click DWORD value.
- ❽ Type "InstalledByUser" (without the quote marks) as the name
- ❾ Touch Enter key, on the keyboard, to finish creating the new Registry value.
- ❿ Try to uninstall Internet Explorer 7 again.
