

LOADING ADDITIONAL LAYER STYLES

Layer Styles that were created on and for Adobe Photoshop can also be utilized in Adobe Photoshop Elements. Here is how to load custom Layer Styles into PSE.

Do not load too many sets into Elements at one time, as this makes the menu for loading them extremely unmanageable.

To load additional Layer Styles:

1. Find the Photoshop Elements program directory, and then the Styles folder, on your hard drive:

*C:\Program Files\Adobe\
Photoshop Elements 6\Presets\Styles*

2. Place the additional Layer Styles in this folder. My folder lists these files. Yours list may differ.

3. Now open Adobe Photoshop Elements.

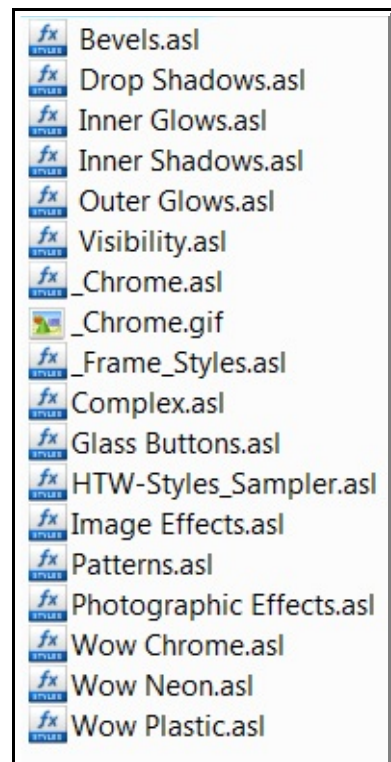

To do so, from the MenuBar, go to
Window ► Content (**Figure 2**).

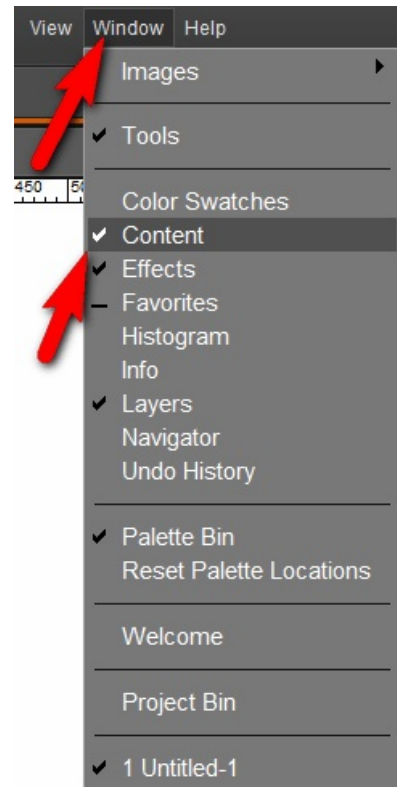
