

# CREATE CD/DVD LABELS

Photoshop Elements offers the creation of CD or DVD labels.

Here's how to do it.

1. Open the Editor.
2. Select "Create"
  - ❶ Click on "Create" button.
  - ❷ Click on "CD/DVD Labels" (Figure 1).

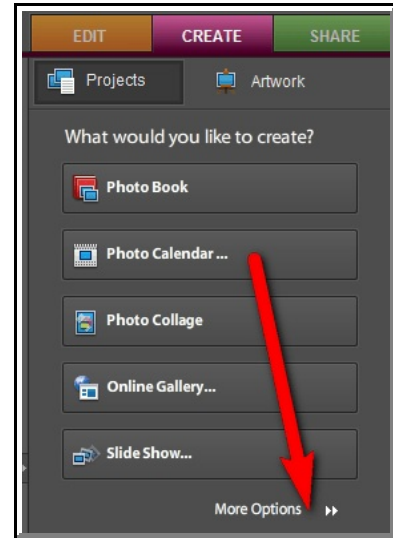

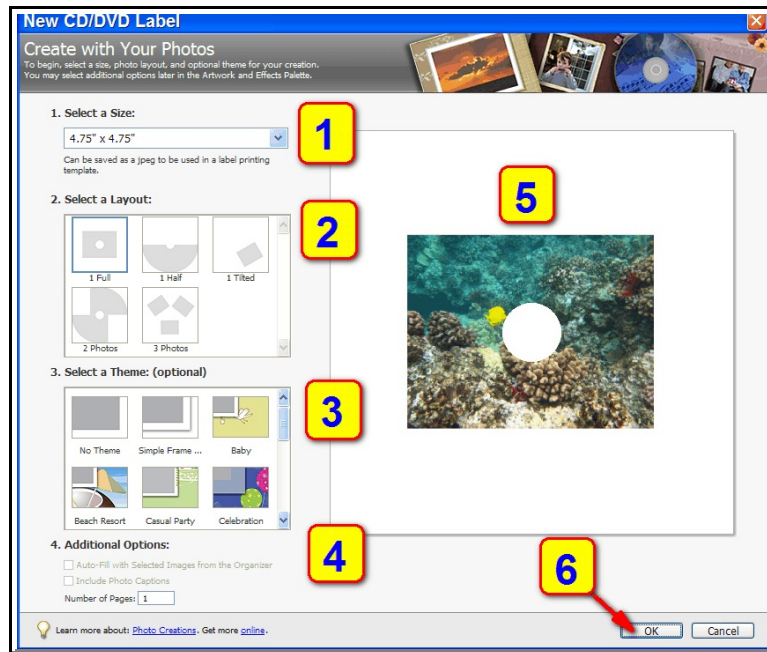


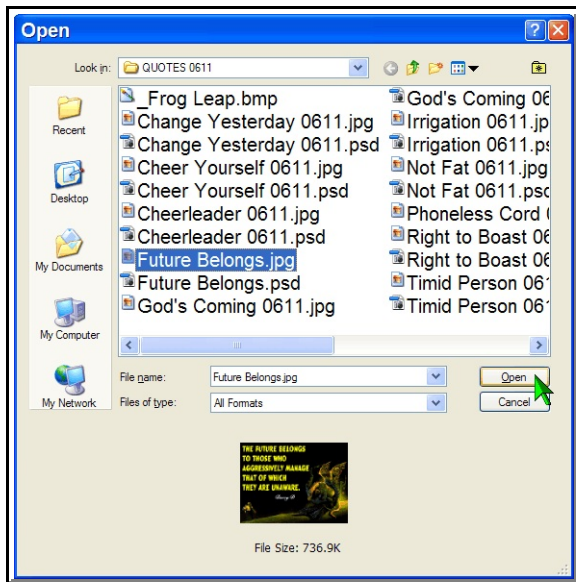

3. Select (Figure 2):
  - ❶ Select the size of the label. Most labels use 4.75" x 4.75".
  - ❷ Select a layout.
  - ❸ Select a Theme — if you are going to create more than one label in a series.
  - ❹ Select additional options.
  - ❺ A preview is provided.
  - ❻ Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the "OK" button.

4. The label appears with a prompt to insert any photo you want (**Figure 3**). Click on the “Click here...” to insert a graphic.

5. Select a graphic (**Figure 4**).

6. You can resize the graphic by using the slider that is provided (**Figure 5**).

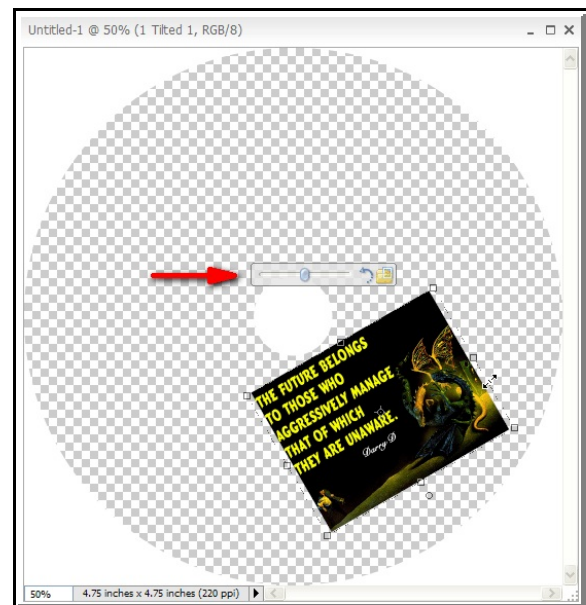
7. From this point on, edit the label like any other graphic. Add text, background, and other items.

8. **SAVE** your graphic.

9. Insert it into your favorite CD Label software.
