This lesson details how to insert Backgrounds.

1. If you're going to use a background, from the Artwork and Effects" menu, I recommend you select "All" before selecting (Figure 1) — thus, giving you many more choices.

NOTE: The selection of "Show All" will only apply during the current session. If you exit and reenter Elements — and desire to show all again — you'll have to repeat this step.

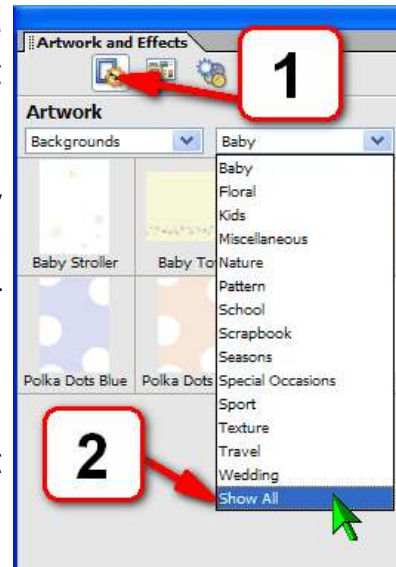

2. Double-click on your choice. That choice is applied to the document upon which you are working (Figure 2).

NOTE: If you decide you do not like that choice, use Ctrl+Z to undo your selection.

3. The result is an appealing background (Figure 3).
