

# Photoshop Elements 5.0 CREATE SLIDES

This lesson details how to create slides, for a slideshow, using Elements.

1. First, you need to create a folder into which the slides may be saved. Use the steps found in my lesson, “Folder, Document Created,” which you’ll find at <http://darryd.com/Windows> .

2. Open Photoshop Elements 5.0 to “Edit and Enhance Photos.”

3. From the MenuBar, select File > New > Create (Figure 1).

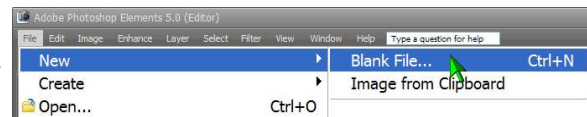

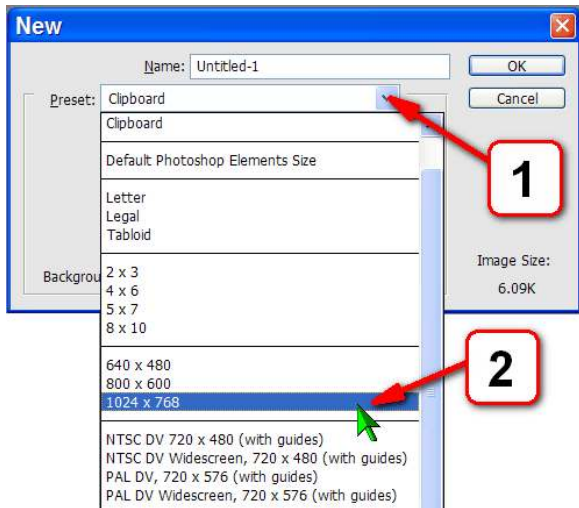

4. Select the “1024x768” pixel document size (Figure 2). This will ensure that the slide shows correctly on every size monitor screen up to 1280x1024 pixels.

5. Ensure that the graphic is Color Mode of “RGB Color”.

6. Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the “OK” button.

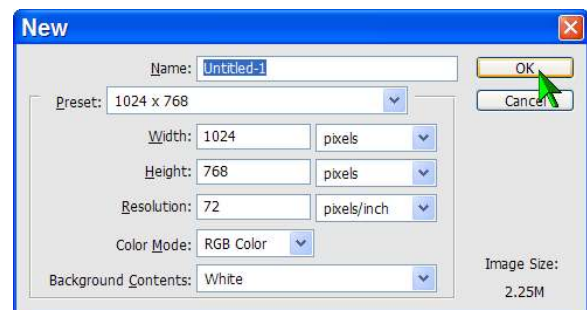
