

# Photoshop Elements 5.0 DOWNLOAD FROM CAMERA PREFERENCES

Elements 5.0 lets you download photos or movies from your camera with more precision than ever. Here's how to set the preferences.

1. Before you begin to download photos from your camera, you must set the preferences in the Organizer. In the Organizer, select **Edit** ► **Preferences** ► **Camera or Card Reader** (**Figure 1**).

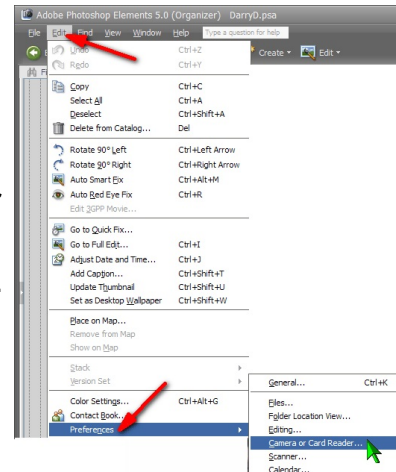

2. The Preferences window opens (**Figure 2**).

- ❶ Click on “Camera or Card Reader” in left pane.
- ❷ Check the folder into which the photos will be downloaded.
- ❸ Click on the Browse button to check the folder or change its location.
- ❹ Ensure there is a ✓ next to “Auto Launch...”
- ❺ Tell Elements when to begin downloading and what name to give to any folders created in the process.
- ❻ You can restore the original settings by clicking on this button.
- ❼ Click “OK” button if satisfied with the result or click “Help” to get more info.

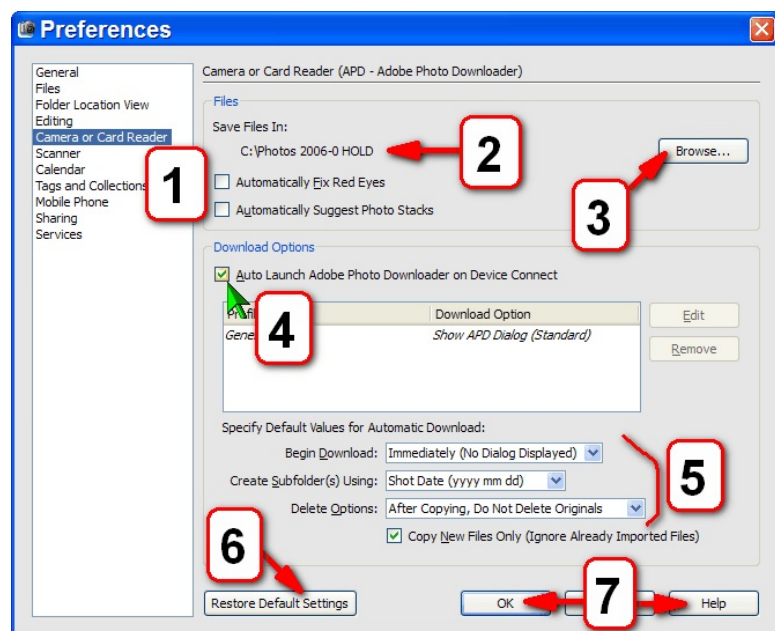
