

ORGANIZER PREFERENCES

After one loads Photoshop Elements 6 onto the PC, it's important to set the preferences for the program. However, preferences must be set separately for the Editor and for the Organizer.

Here's how to do it in the Organizer.

1. When you open Elements, select Organize. Once inside, from the Menu-Bar, select Edit > Preferences > General (Figure 1).

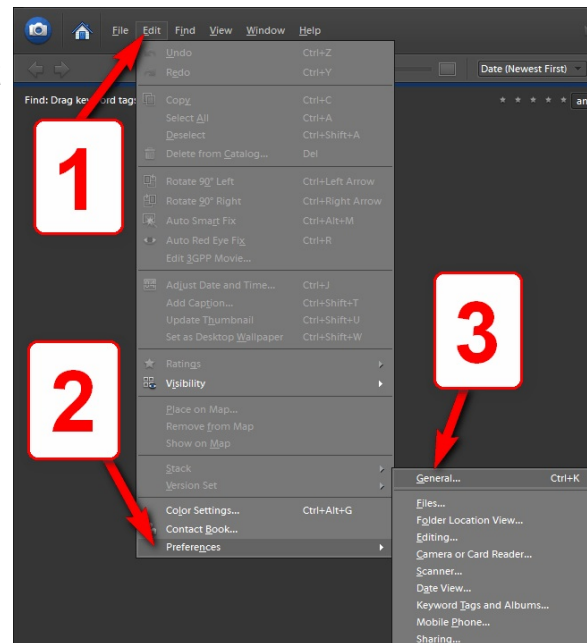

2. In the General area, (**Figure 2**) these settings should show.

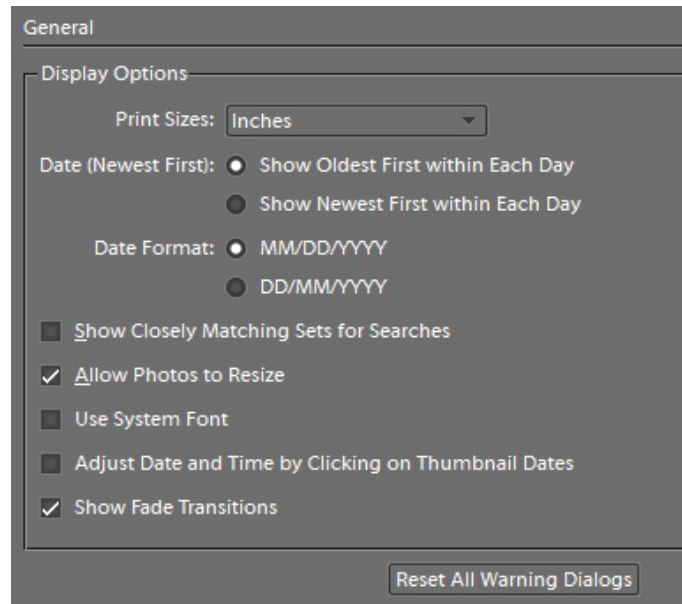

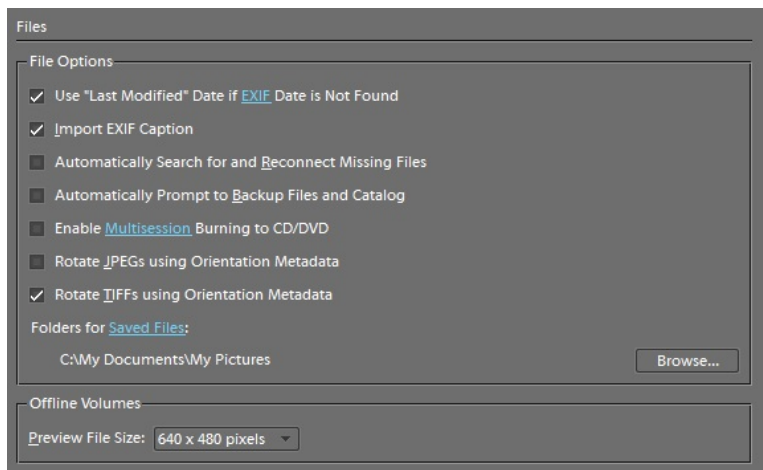

3. In the Files (**Figure 3**), viewed by clicking on “Files” on the left-side of the window, enter these changes.

4. In Folder Location View (**Figure 4**), leave the default selection.

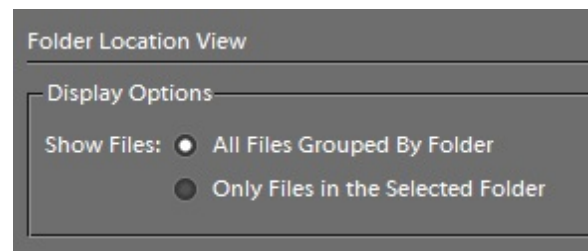

5. In the Supplementary Editing Application window (**Figure 5**), you can specify additional editing applications, like Adobe's InDesign.

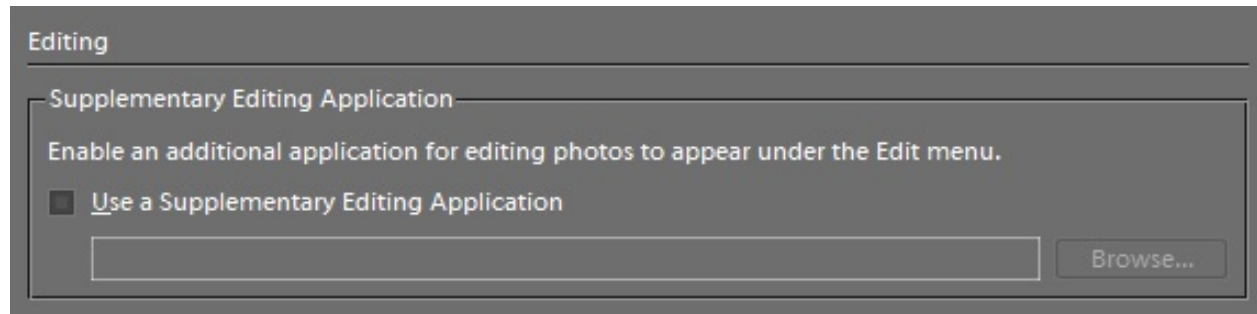

6. In the Camera or Card Reader (**Figure 6**), you'll specify to the folder into which you want photos to be placed.

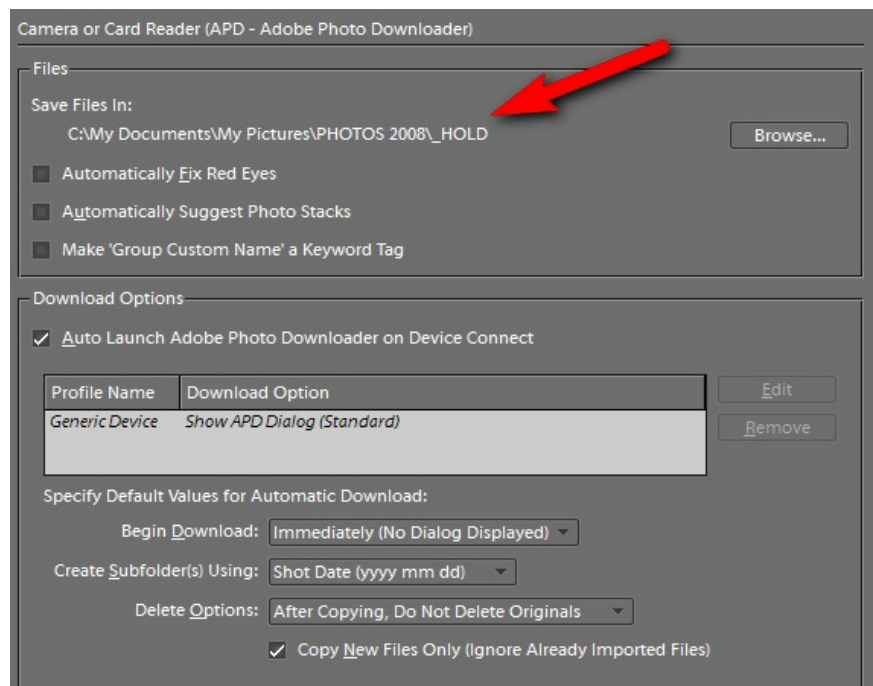

7. In the Scanner area:

- ❶ Select your scanner. If there are two choices for your scanner, select the one that has TWAIN as a part of its name.
- ❷ Use the Browse button to select where you want scanned graphics to be saved.

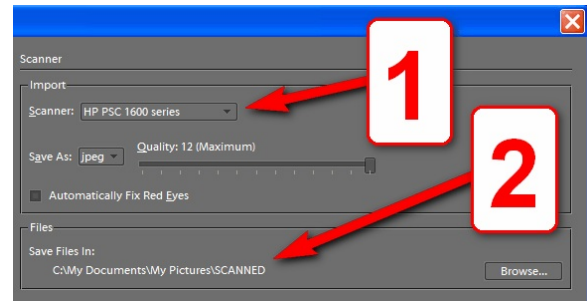

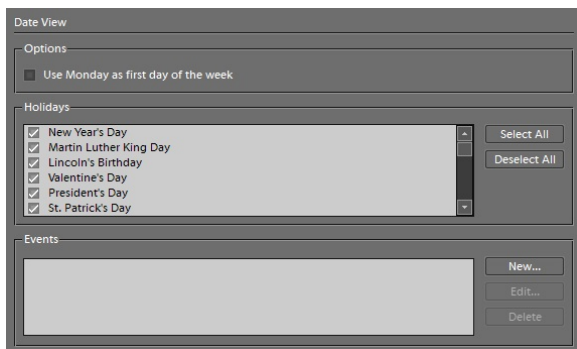

8. In the Date View (**Figure 8**), you can select which holidays you want included in your calendars. (I removed the Great Britain holidays, but saved the Canadian holidays.)

9. In the Keyword Tags and Albums (**Figure 9**), you can change their settings.

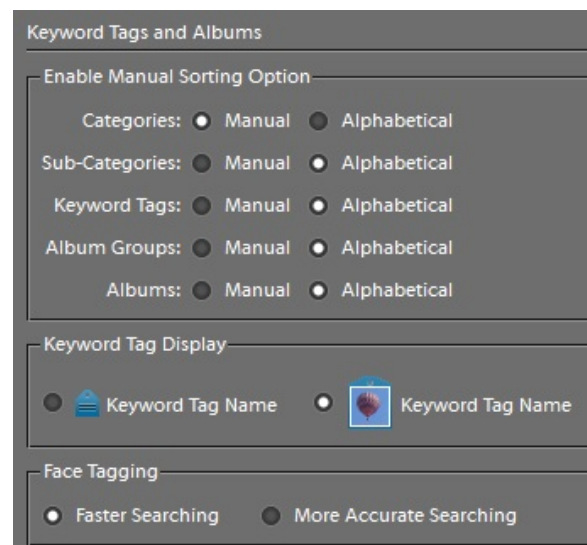

10. If you use a cell phone, you can select how photos are saved from it to Elements (**Figure 10**).

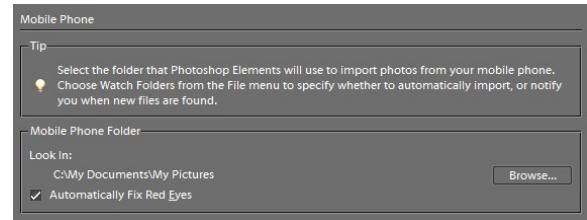

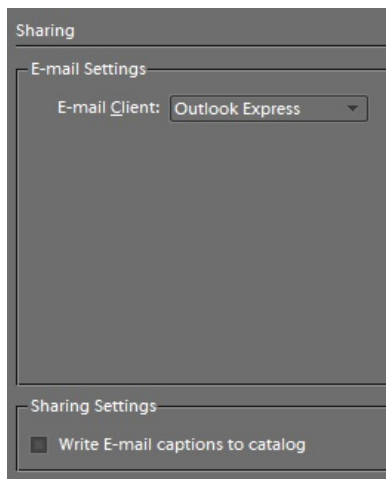

11. In the Sharing (**Figure 11**), you select your email program and if you want captions automatically added to any photos you send.

12. The Adobe Partner Services is just a way for Adobe to spam you via Elements (**Figure 12**). As you can see, I turned off the “Automatically check for services.”

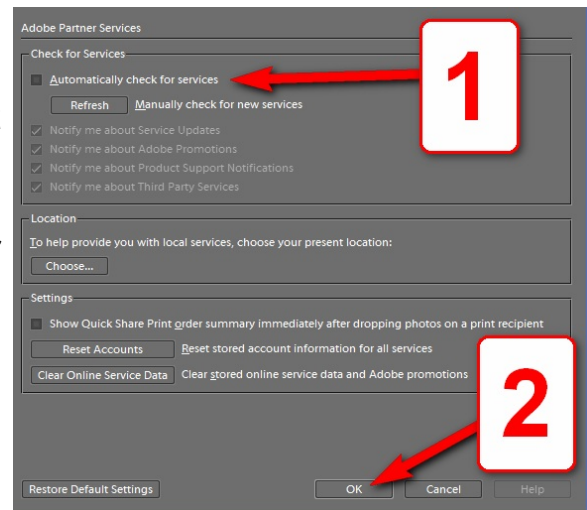
