

Farm Town Hints & Tricks

LAYERING TREES ON TOP OF PLOTS

This is “Layering Trees on Top of Plots” — but really “Layering Plots on Top of Trees”. **This same technique works for buildings, flowers and some decorations too!**

1. Clear off all land to naked earth (the base layer).

2. Put trees in — in rows or at random. If you want to look at an example of each, come to my farm #1 (random) or the rest of my farms for horizontal.

➤ If you own the Tree Harvester (which I recommend if you have lots of trees), it’s actually easier to harvest if the trees are right next to one another, both vertically and horizontally.

➤ If you use a grid clicker it’s easier to harvest if you plant the trees horizontally rather than vertically and leave a space between trees and a little room between rows.

3. Click on the ❶ Wrench (Preferences), in upper right of the farm, and ❷ turn off trees. Where the trees were, there will be red squares (**Figure 1**).

4. Go to another farm.

5. Come back to this farm. The red squares will disappear. They must be gone for this technique to work.



6. Find an open area on your farm, and click on the Hoe (Figure 2).

7. Put down one plot (so you have to make sure you have an opened area).

8. Then ❶ go to the Tool Box and ❷ choose the Tractor to delete the plot (Figure 3).

9. Now go to 4x plow (or single) and begin putting in plots.

NOTES:

❶ I have had some glitches lately, and have had to go all the way out (Step 4 above) to Facebook and back, and redo Step 6 to get it to work.

❷ I have even had to fiddle with it several times, so don't get discouraged. It will work, and if not, I will come to the rescue. It's just being temperamental (a male program to be sure).
