1. Open PhraseExpress (**Figure 1**) by clicking on its icon & then clicking on “Settings” option.

2. Make the change (**Figure 2**):

- 1 Left-click on the phrase.
- 2 Edit the Description.
- 3 Edit the Phrase content.
- 4 Assign a Hotkey if you want.
- 5 Edit the Autotext.
- 6 You can use the Search (magnifying glass icon) if you don't see the phrase.
- 7 You can change the execution method.
- 8 Left-click on “OK” button.

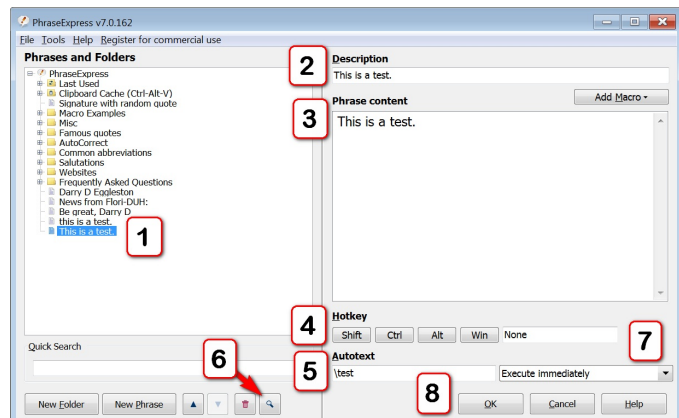
