The easiest way to create a System Restore Point in Windows Vista is to begin by creating a System Restore Point Shortcut on the desktop. Go to http://darryd.com/Vista/System_Restore_Shortcut.pdf to create that point.

This lesson shows how to use that shortcut.

1. Double, left-click on the shortcut's icon (**Figure 1**).

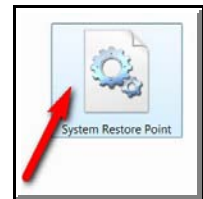
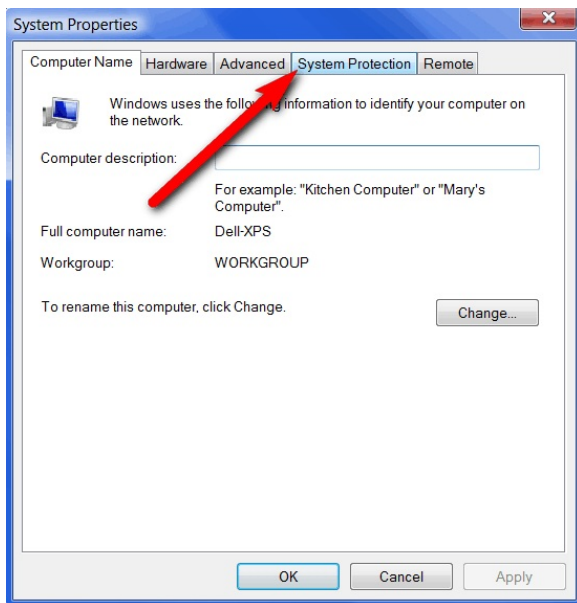

2. Left-click on "System Protection" tab (**Figure 2**).

3. Select Create option (Figure 3):

- 1 Wait until the C drive is shown.
- 2 Left-click on "Create" button.

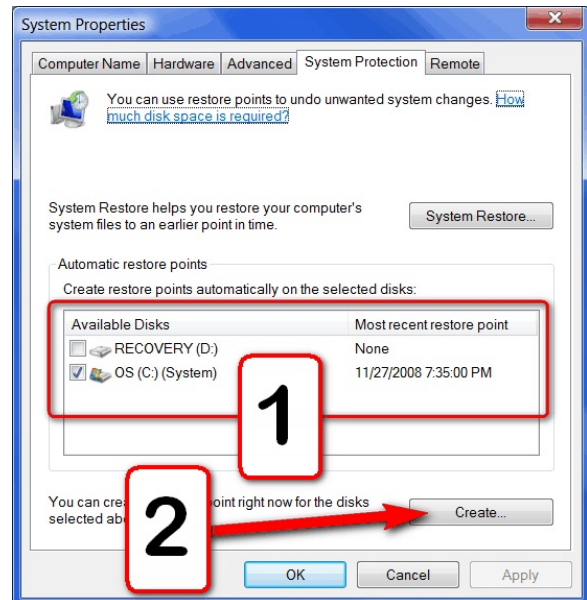

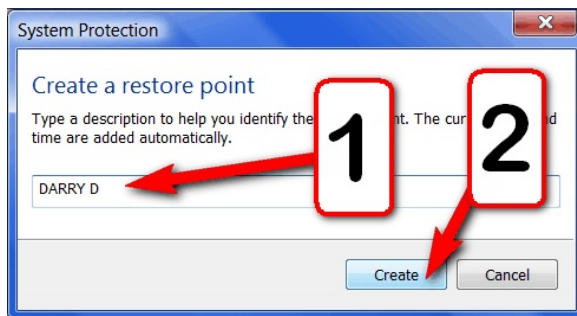

4. Create the point (Figure 4):

- 1 Type a name for the point.
- 2 Left-click on "Create" button.

5. The system will notify you when the point has been created (Figure 5).

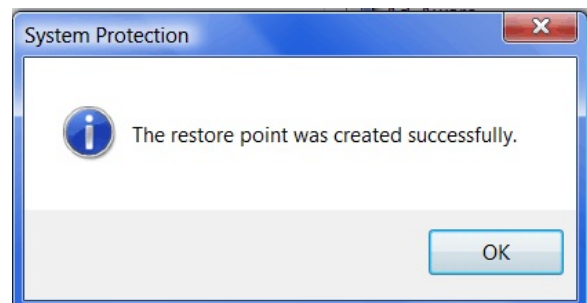
