Sometimes you see a problem in a document and you don't know how to fix it.

Figure 1 is one such problem. For some reason, only 3 words appear on the last line of the page. (The “|” is the cursor's position.)

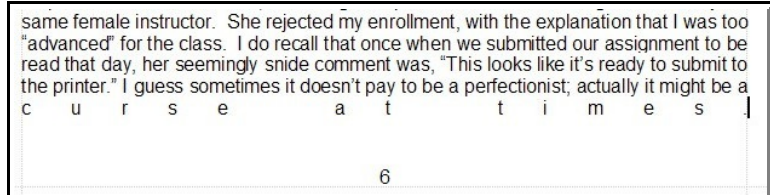

Fortunately, WP has Reveal Codes (View ► Reveal Codes or Alt+F3). Codes are displayed in boxes in WP, but I'll use brackets — [] — in this lesson. Now one sees the causes (**Figure 2**):

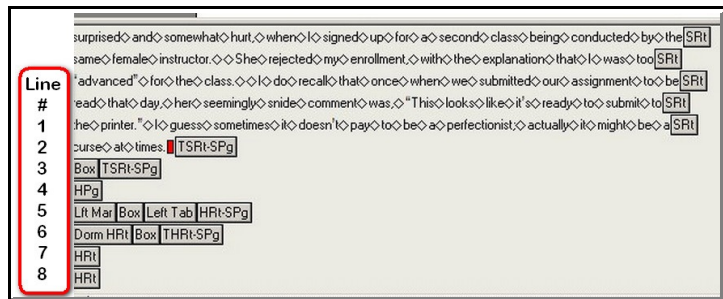

Line ❶, and the previous lines, the words wrap: [Srt].

Line ❷ wraps at the end of a page [TSRt-SPg] because of a graphic [Box] (Line ❸) inserted at the bottom of the page HPg (Line ❹). That graphic's size is too large to be displayed on that page so it wraps to the next page.

On Line ❺, the left margin [Lft Mar] has been changed from its default, a graphic [Box] and a left tab [Left Tab] has been inserted but the combination of the previous graphic and this one caused the page to wrap [HRt-SPg].
