From time-to-time, you're going to want to know what version of a program you are using.

While I'll be using WordPerfect as the example, the process for determining the version is the same in any Windows programs.

Here's how.

- 1. Open the program.
- 2. From the MenuBar (**Figure 1**), select Help → About....
