

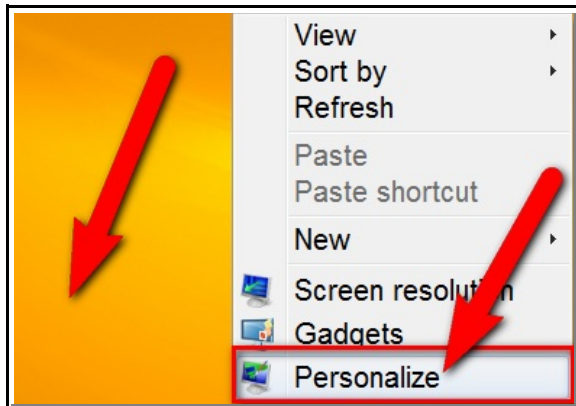


Windows 7 INSTALL DUAL MONITORS

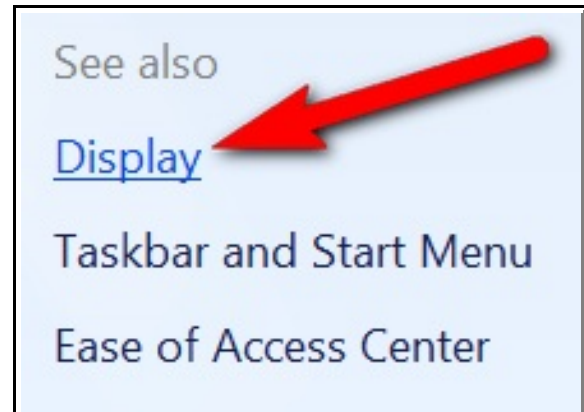

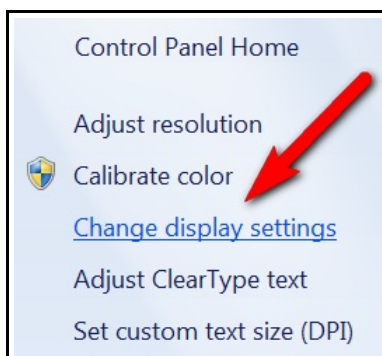
Once the graphics board is installed, you must tell Windows 7 about your second monitor.



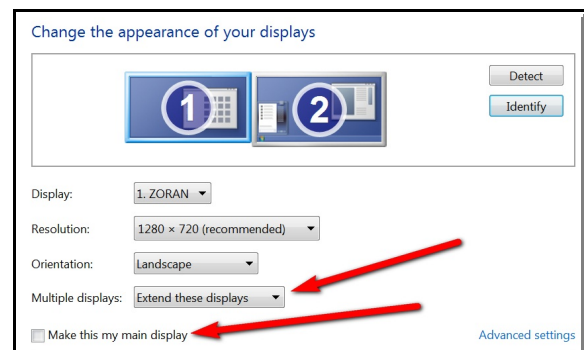
1 — ① RIGHT-click on Desktop,
② Left-click on Personalize



2 — Lower, left column.



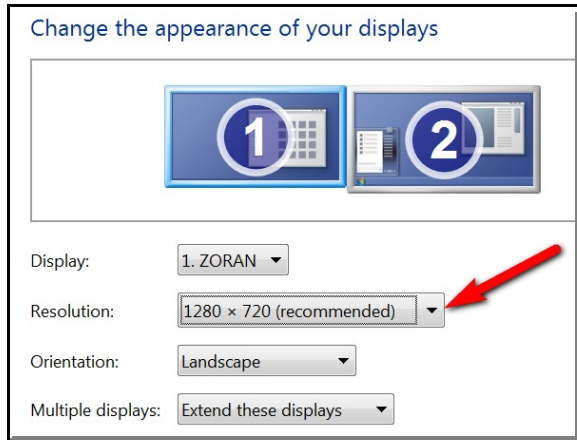
3 — Upper, left column.



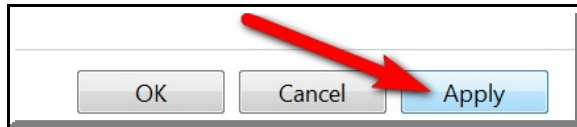
4 — ① Extend Displays
② Make this Main Display.
NOTE: 2nd monitor may not show until after step ①

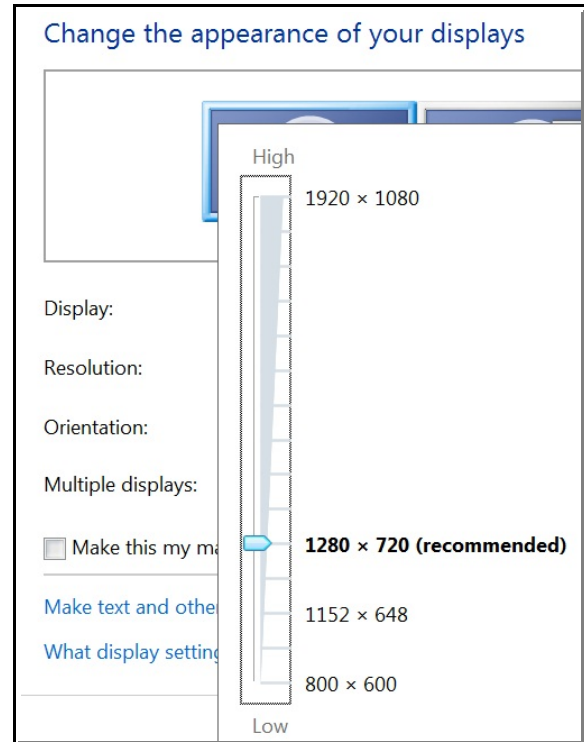
To Adjust Resolution — OPTIONAL:
