



# Windows 7 STARTUP FILES

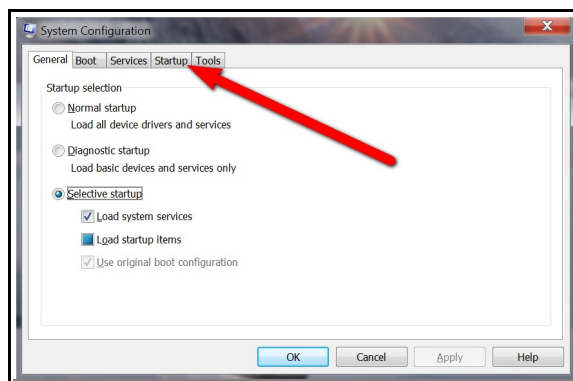
This is how to select which programs automatically load when you startup Windows.

1. With all programs closed, Left-click on the Start button, & type MSCONFIG into the search window (**Figure 1**).

2. Left-click on the “Startup” tab (**Figure 2**).

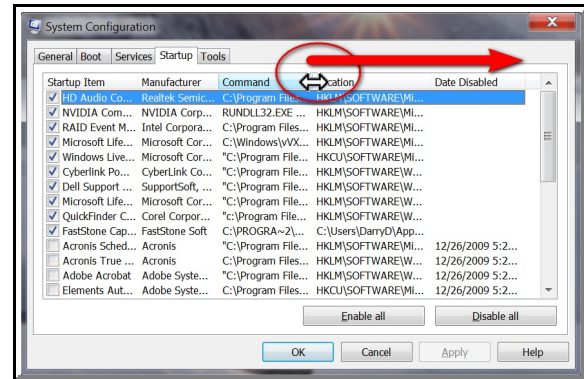

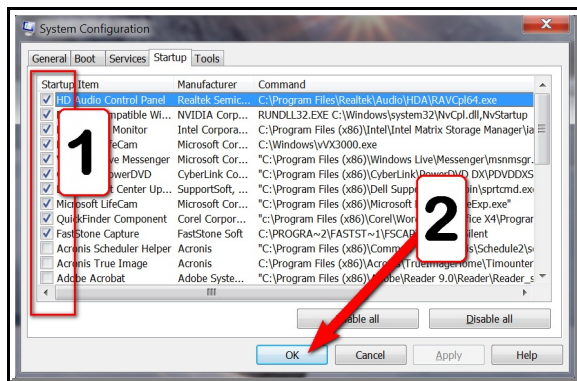

3. Widen the “Command” column by left-clicking, holding, and dragging the right-side of the column as far to the right as you can go (**Figure 3**).

4. Select which programs will run when Windows starts (**Figure 4**):

- ① A ✓ next to a program means it will run automatically. If there is a check and you don't want it, left-click on the ✓ to remove it.
- ② Left-click on “OK” button.

5. Restart your computer.
