

Windows 7 SYSTEM RESTORE

If your system is infected — or you suspect it is — the easiest way to fix it is to use System Restore. This is how to do it in Windows 7.

- 1. With all programs closed, from the desktop, select Start button and then Control Panel (**Figure 1**).
- 2. In the Control Panel, Left-click on "System" (Figure 2).



3. Left-click on "System Protection" in the left column (**Figure 3**).



4. Left-click on "System Restore" button (**Figure 4**).

5. Left-click on the "Next" button (**Figure 5**).





- 6. Follow the prompts.
- 7. Pick a point TWO DAYS before you had the problem.
