



Windows 7 SYSTEM RESTORE

If your system is infected — or you suspect it is — the easiest way to fix it is to use System Restore. This is how to do it in Windows 7.

1. With all programs closed, from the desktop, select Start button and then Control Panel (**Figure 1**).

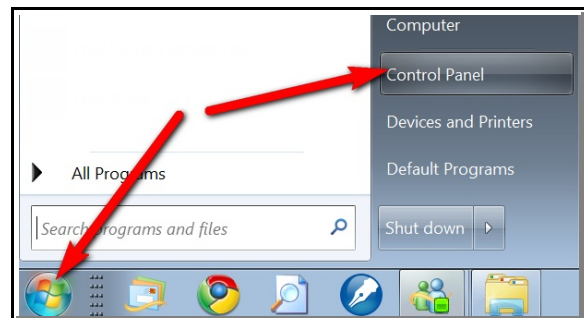

2. In the Control Panel, Left-click on “System” (**Figure 2**).

3. Left-click on “System Protection” in the left column (**Figure 3**).

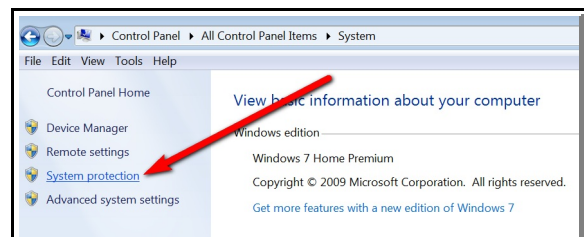

4. Left-click on “System Restore” button (Figure 4).

5. Left-click on the “Next” button (Figure 5).

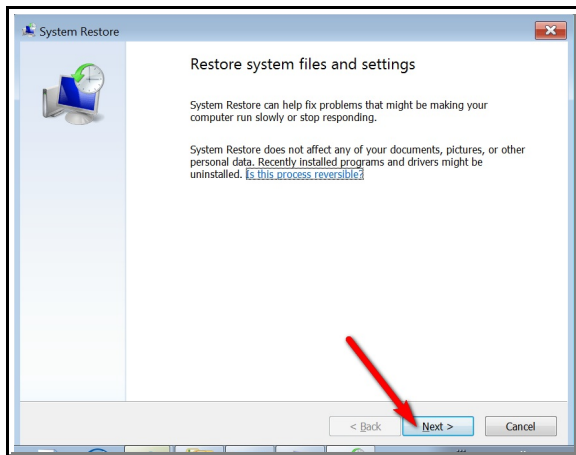

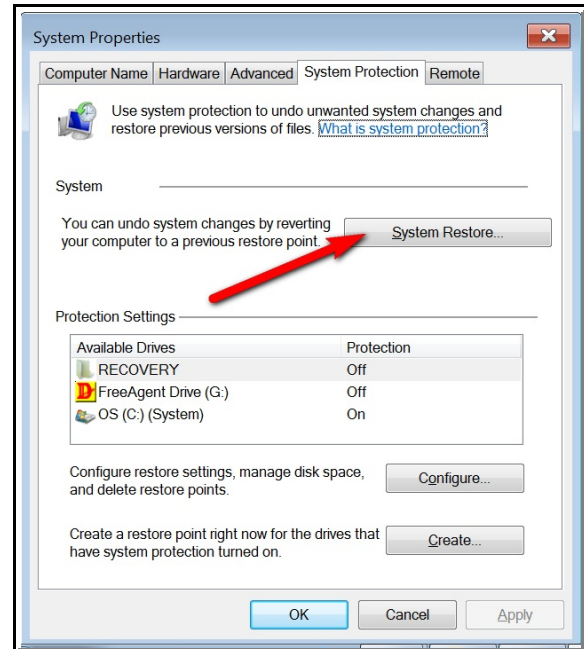

6. Follow the prompts.

7. Pick a point TWO DAYS before you had the problem.

There is NO affect upon any photos, documents, & emails you got during the period that is *not* covered by this restore. It only affects ‘system files’.
