This is how to select which programs automatically load when you startup Windows XP, Vista or 7.

With all programs closed, from the desktop, select ❶ Start ► ❷ Run (Figure 1).

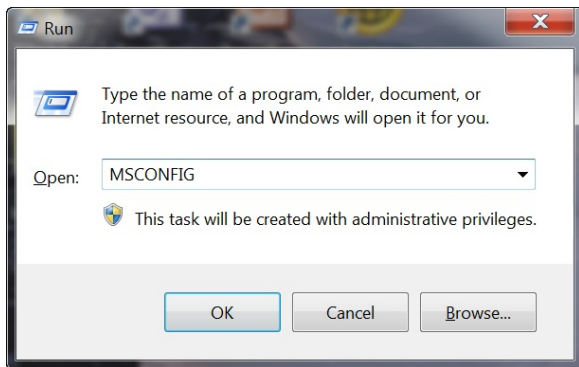

2. Type “MSCONFIG” — without the quotes — and left-click on “OK” button (Figure 2).

3. Left-click on the “Startup” tab (Figure 3).

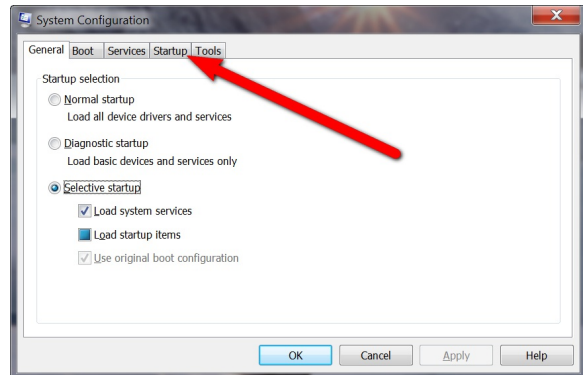

4. Widen the “Command” column by left-clicking, holding, and dragging the right-side of the column as far to the right as you can go (**Figure 4**).

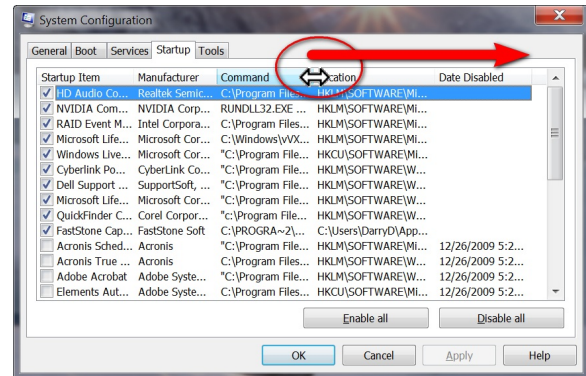

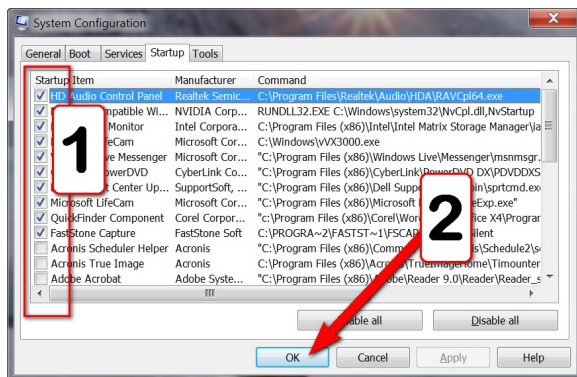

5. Select which programs will run when Windows starts (**Figure 5**):

- ❶ A ✓ next to a program means it will run. If there is a check and you don't want it, left-click on the ✓ to remove it.
- ❷ Left-click on “OK” button.
