1. Select Start > Control Panel.
2. Double, left-click on the “Automatic Updates” icon (Figure 1).

3. The “Automatic Updates” window appears with three options (Figure 2):

❖ The first is update your PC automatically. I do not recommend this because some times Microsoft issues fixes that cause more problems than they solve.

❖ The second option will tell you if an update is available and allow you to control this. Your system will still access the Web to see if an update is available; but, it will wait for you to decide which updates to install.

NOTE: Only install “Critical Updates”.

4. Touch the *Enter* key, on the keyboard, or click on the “OK” button.
