

# CLEAN AN LCD SCREEN

Here's how to clean the liquid crystal display (LCD) on your laptop or attached to your Desktop PC:

1. Use a soft cotton cloth like a soft wash cloth. Do not use paper towels or dried-out wash cloths as both of these will scratch your screen.
2. You can use — in order — water, vinegar (mixed with water) or isopropyl alcohol. Only use computer wipes if they specifically state that they are designed for LCD laptop screens.
3. Always apply the solution to your cloth first; never spray any liquids on the LCD screen directly.
4. Lightly wipe the cloth across the display from the top-to-bottom.
