In a recent survey of a computer club, many did not know which version of Windows they were using or how much random access memory (RAM) was on their system.

Here is a quick way for you to tell what's on your system.

1. From the Desktop, select Start > Run.
2. In the Run window, type "WinVer" — without the quote marks (Figure 1). Uppercase or lowercase is accepted.

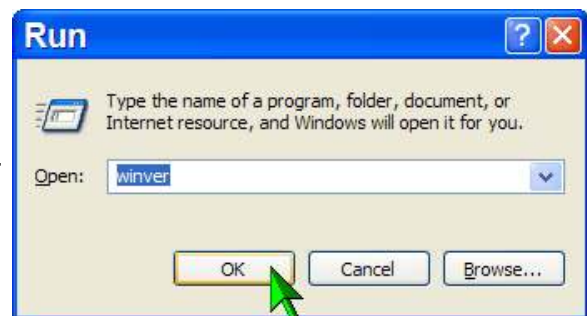

3. Note the information displayed (Figure 2):

- ❶ The actual version of Windows you're using.
- ❷ To whom the software is licensed.
- ❸ The amount of RAM.
